Special Prizes

Perpetual prizes, trophies and any special prizes relating to a specific class are detailed with that class.

Rules:

1. All classes are held under the general rules and conditions of the Festival.
2. All cattle entered in the show must be the bone fide property of the exhibitor at the closing date for entries to the show. Exhibitors must be resident in Great Britain.
3. All cattle must be registered in the appropriate Herd Book. The show is open to breeds currently listed on the RBST Watchlist (1-5) See Appendix A.
4. No animal may compete in more than one class unless specifically stated in the class description.
5. The show will be open for entries at 8am on **Friday 17th September**. Entries must be completed in full and must be entered into the show software no later than 8pm on **Friday 1st October**.

Each entry must be accompanied by four colour photographs – one from the front, one from the rear and one from each side of the animal. The animal need not be haltered but should be standing on a level surface such that the judges can see the lower legs and feet.

All photographs must be in landscape orientation.

All photographs must have been taken in 2021.

Exhibitors must also provide the full pedigree name of the animal, UK eartag

number, date of birth and Herd Book number.

6. **Judging will commence immediately after the closing date.** Results will be announced at noon on **Saturday 23rd October.**
7. With the exception of the Steward, or other representative of the Organiser, no person will be permitted to be in contact with the Judges on any pretext.
8. Any protests must be lodged with the Organiser in writing, before 3pm on the day of the Festival. The Organiser reserves the right to settle all protests or disputes that may arise and that decision is final.
9. Rosettes, prize cards and any special prizes will be posted to exhibitors after the show.
10. Where prizes or donations have been made for any particular class or purpose, such prize or donation will be awarded to that class or purpose for which it was given.
11. All judging will be done from photographs supplied. Male animals will not have been judged for reproductive correctness.
